NOTED ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Eight churches have been established. The pastor in charge of each church has gone through our training in Berean Grace School of Ministry (BGSB). Training potential leaders has been one of the KEY ministry strategies in reaching



the coastal region with the gospel of the grace of God.

Four Bible training centers have been established within the span of three years. More than 50 students have been enrolled in our centers. A number of them are continuing with advanced levels, while a few have stopped after finishing Level One of their studies.

We can't forget to thank the TCM Executive Director, Ben Anderson,



for his visit to Mombasa last year during Africa Safari. He encouraged the BGSB students to become faithful by teaching others what they have learned. He held a seminar and taught Grace leaders within the coastal region of Kenya and clearly taught the Troas Strategy of church planting, illustrating Paul's method of planting churches (Target, Plant, Train, Release and Partner). Ben also mentioned three areas that must be worked out in our lives, that is **knowing, being and doing**. They are inseparable.
