# A "Flashback" of TCM's 60th Foundation Anniversary

"The countdown begins!"

This microphone-deafening announcement came from the huge colorfully decorated platform of the new TCM Convention Center in the Philippines. A spectacular five-minute fireworks display followed which caught the full attention of more than 2,000-overly excited strong audience that attended the opening night of the 60th TCM Founding Anniversary & Thanksgiving Celebration in Lupagan where TCM missionaries, Vernon & Darlene Anderson and Joe & Pauline Watkins, began ministry in 1958!

The opening ceremonies paraded colorful flags representing the TCM mission fields of 17 countries from Southeast Asia, Africa, Africa, Europe, and America. More than 50 TCM missionaries and guests from these countries graced the historical event. Ben Anderson, Tim Heath, Don Sommer, Felix Rosales, Titus Kivilu, Nathan Killion, and James Bermejo took turns in delivering strong and spiritually-enriching messages during the worship services centering on the theme: "TCM at 60: Faithfully Proclaiming the Mystery".



"TCM Target 2023"

'Mission: Impossible"?



This current five-year development plan of Things to Come Mission, Philippines aims at reaching the following goals from 2018-2023: Plant 135 new churches; Add 9,275 new members; Raise 25 million pesos; and, Train laypeople and key leaders in the local, district, and zonal levels.

During the last five years (2013-2017), the Mission launched a development plan known as "TCM IMPACT". The plan targeted to plant 115 new churches; add 7, 725 new members; raise 20 million pesos; and, train laypeople and key leaders through the Mission's continuing education program. The results? 99 new churches were planted; number of individuals added overshot the target; and, 120 laypeople and 282 key leaders completed the continuing education program. The targeted 20 million pesos, however, only a little more than half of the amount was raised.

Based on the results of the previous plan, the present program has more encouraging advantages and strongly motivated challenges!

The participants of the TCM Philippines National Summit last February in Tagum City and Surigao City were unanimous in

their strong declaration, that by the grace God, "TCM Target 2023" will again become an effective tool of church growth for Things to Come Mission, Philippines in the next five years! "Mission: Impossible"? Definitely not!

"Support Goals" of Literature Department for "TCM Target 2023"

Produce follow up materials for new believers;

- Assist in the production of training materials for laypeople and key leaders of the Mission;
- Participate in leadership training seminars in the local, district and zonal levels;
- Secure reference books and study materials for workers in the field;
- Organize teams in the churches to conduct seasonal massive gospel tracts distribution;
- Offer Bible courses on the basics of salvation as well as helps on spiritual growth through correspondence and seminars; and,
- Help keep people updated on the progress of the development plan both in the leadership and grassroots levels.

# Where is TCM Now as a Mission?

"God's Word Challenges the Believers to Evangelize!"



TCM is now in all 18 Regions in the Philippines; 54 out of 82 Provinces; 40 out of 145 Cities; 48 out 1,489 Municipalities; and 362 out 42,036 Barangays, or a total 512 Grace Gospel Churches. This means TCM's membership represents a notable spectrum of society in the Philippines. However, our country's present population is now 106,512,074 (2018 Philippine Statistics Authority)!


God's Word strongly re-echoes the same challenge for believers to evangelize:

### Young Men Wanted!

As Ezra prepared to lead God's people back to the Promised Land after the Babylonian captivity, he had plenty of money to buy animals for sacrifice in the newly rebuilt temple (Ezra 7:11-17), but no Levites to offer them (8:15). This reminds me of the situation in our own day. Grace churches frequently have




enough money to serve the Lord, but no men willing to offer their bodies as "a living sacrifice" to God (Rom. 12:1). Will you be such a man, willing to serve Him in

the ministry? I'm reminded of the Lord's lament to men of God in Ezekiel's day: "Ye have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD" (Ezek. 13:5). As grace pastors retire and others go to be with the Lord, there are always going to be gaps that need to be filled in the front lines of the battle for truth. - Message under the present Dispensation of Grace (Mystery Program);
- Kept secret until revealed through the Apostle Paul;
- Focuses on Heaven;
- Focuses on Christ being the Head of the Church, the Body of Christ;
- Teaches that salvation is by faith with no works;

- Reveals that Christ died for all mankind equally;
- Teaches that we receive salvation the moment we believe and are sealed to the end; and,
- Anticipates Christ's coming to catch away the Body of Christ (believers) into Heaven (Rapture).

### ❖ The "Gospel of the Kingdom":

- Message under the Kingdom Dispensation (Prophecy Program);
- Prophesied since the world began and entrusted to the 12 Apostles;
- Focuses on the physical kingdom on earth;
- Focuses on Christ being King of Israel (His nation);
- Teaches that salvation is faith plus works (keeping the commandments);
- Revealed that Christ would die for Israel (many);
- Teaches that salvation is achieved

by overcoming and enduring to the end; and,

- Anticipates Christ's coming to earth to take vengeance on the wicked and set up His kingdom (Second Coming).
- Studying the Bible "rightly divided" will save us from many doctrinal errors, and will enlighten us to the power of God's will.
