

AN EYE-WITNESS REPORT LATEST REPORT ON SUPER TYPHOON YOLANDA CONFIRMS THE FOLLOWING:

1. Manticaan, Leyte (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members totally destroyed – 3);
2. Ormoc House Church, Leyte (totally destroyed);
3. Hibulangan, Leyte (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members partially destroyed – 7);
4. Campurog, Leyte (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members partially destroyed, including Bible woman Lourdes Impas' house – 16);
5. Palompon, Leyte (roof of bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members totally destroyed – 3; houses of members partially destroyed, including the house of Pastor Jo Sampitan);
6. Jordan, Leyte (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members partially damaged – 4);
7. Biliran, Leyte (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of member partially damaged – 4);
8. Honan, Leyte (bldg. slightly damaged; pastoral house totally destroyed; houses of members partially destroyed – 13);
9. Matlang, Leyte (bldg. slightly damaged; pastoral house slightly damaged);
10. Lanipga, Leyte (roof of pastoral house totally destroyed; houses of members totally destroyed – 6; houses of members partially destroyed – 18);
11. Pintuyan House Church, Leyte (bldg. and houses of members slightly damaged);
12. Mahaplag, Leyte (bldg. and houses of members slightly damaged);
13. Hinunangan, Leyte (pastoral house and members' houses slightly damaged);
14. Bato, Leyte (only houses of members are slightly affected);
15. Tacloban, Leyte (bldg. no damage; family of Pastor Gil Carangue and members are safe in the ABS CBN bldg.);
16. Tabogon, Cebu (bldg no damage; houses of members partially destroyed – 7);
- 17, 18, 19. Sunog, Poro, Villahermosa in Camotes Island, Cebu province (bldgs. No damage; houses of members partially destroyed);
20. Molocaboc, Neg. Occ. (bldg. totally destroyed; houses of members partially destroyed); and,
21. Idupoy in Cuyo Island (bldg. totally destroyed; houses partially destroyed – 7).

This latest summarized report was gathered from the reports sent by TCM Supervising Ministers Ben Sausa (Leyte), Jessie Crescencio (Cebu), Ortes Condrillon (Southwestern Luzon), and Noel Sanchez (pastor of the GGCC, Molocaboc Island (Negros Occ.)).
