Services and Sister Malavy is facilitating a bi-monthly Bible Study for them.

Every other Thursday, we hold a Prayer Night Fellowship. This activity focuses more on praying for the wellbeing of every



member. This time is also spent praying for TCM leadership, missionaries and the ministries that the Lord has entrusted to us here in Cambodia.

CGGM Cheutiel Village Ministries (Takeo Province)



When the Mahilums, the pioneer missionaries, went back to the Philippines for good, some of the youth stopped attending the worship service. However, during this time of adjustment and transition, we were able to

discover those who are really passionate and have strong faith in the Lord. Some faithful youth still regularly attend and facilitate the worship services in the village with the support of the national leadership on a monthly visitation schedule. Vorleak, one of the fruits of the village

ministry, continues to teach English & Bible classes at her house with several neighbors, especially young kids from her area.
