Thailand



The Killions have been serving with Things to Come Mission in Thailand for the past 8 years. From now until July of 2017 they will be traveling throughout the United States and sharing about how God is at work in the Buddhist country of Thailand.

Nathan and Jessica met while attending Grace Bible College. In 1999 they were married and in 2002 their son, Matthias, was born. That same year the Lord led them to accept a pastorate at Faith Bible Church in Olney, Illinois, where they served for 5 ½ years. It was there that their daughters Abigail (2004) and Chloe (2006) were born. This was a meaningful time of growth for the Killions as they built lasting friendships and the Lord taught them many lessons on raising a family and serving in full time ministry.

Throughout their years in college and pastoral ministry, the Killions were directly involved in mission. Nathan visited the Philippines twice, and both Nathan and Jessica took part in TCM's Africa Safari to Kenya in 2007. During that trip the Lord confirmed His desire for them to become full time missionaries. Around that same time, Genesis and Verna Maraat encouraged and challenged Nathan and Jessica to consider serving

as missionaries to the people of Thailand. It was soon afterwards that the Killions made a decision to follow God's leading and prepare to move overseas. In late 2008, after 11 months of visiting churches and raising support, the Killions left for Thailand.

The Killions' first term in Thailand was spent learning and planting seeds. They invested much time in language and culture study as well as discovering effective methods to share the gospel with the Thai people. During their second term they helped begin and lead Grace Church in the city of Chiang Mai. More recently they have been working to start an outreach ministry called House of Grace in a community outside of the city. Using the method of biblical storytelling, their primary goal in these ministries is to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ to the Thai people and establish local churches.

When they return to Thailand in July of 2017, the Killions plan to continue in these areas so that it can be said of many Thai people that they "turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come" (1 Thessalonians 1:9-10).
