We arrived in Siem Reap City on November 10, 2013. Siem Reap is our new church planting location after staying and planting a church in Phnom Penh City and villages of Takeo. We turned over the work to our Cambodian Pastors Sruoch Sorn and Chrorn Sorn and Missionary Myra Omictin, to continue the work started in 2007. Praise God for what He is doing in the lives of our Pastors and members in Phnom Penh City and the four villages of Takeo Province.

Siem Reap Province is the third largest in Cambodia with Siem Reap City as its capital. It is the tourism capital of Cambodia because of the Angkor Wat (famous Buddhist temple). The city population is nine hundred thousand. We are renting a 2-storey building as our base where we meet for worship every Sunday morning. We go to Banteay Srey Village every Saturday to teach the Bible to a family. We have started to make friends with our neighbors in the city and pray for opportunities to share Jesus with them. Sharing the gospel to Buddhists is a long process, but praise God for open doors.

Our plan is to continue language study this year. Faith is going to a language school three-times per week taking conversation lessons. She's never been to a language school because she was working in past years to augment our financial needs on the field. This year we just want to focus on enhancing our language acquisition. Next month we will start our Khmer Bible words with the Cambodia Bible Society. The Lord used a different system when we started in Phnom Penh City because we trained our people in English which resulted in English-speaking core membership in Phnom Penh City. This time, we want to use more time for language acquisition. However, we still do Bible Study and conduct training for our Phnom Penh members while we share the gospel in Siem Reap.

In closing, we are grateful for your commitment in standing with us in the mission field through prayers and finances. The Lord will never forget what you have done, and we pray for blessings coming your way from God Almighty.
