but ithey are not a substitute for our relationship to God and our partnership in the gospel ministry–which are the real means of our communication. Our faith is tested all the time when we have family needs identified and unidentified in our wants and projects in the ministry. God answers all our prayers. It is a lesson to learn in God's Word that patience follows standing still and trusting, letting God do His part with no instruction from us! We need to do what we do best and we know it will work despite interventions, just learning to trust the Lord for what is best for us.

This last quarter of 2012 is a concise achievement in the ministry and a projection of the year to come, to pursue what the Lord called us to do:

- Church in Luzira the landlord will sell us the land we are presently renting, worth 28 million Uganda shillings (\$11,000). Please pray for God's provision.
- Muyenga Church building project needs the roof and wall in order to be usable for worship and class room for training students for God's ministry. \$10,000 can cover the whole area.
- Continued training of members and youth for ministry in the local church.
- Children's ministry, particularly this quarter, as many spend holidays in their homes. We need something for them at this Christmas season.
- Evangelism is the key to growth of the local church. Pray for passion for souls to be brought to a saving relationship with Jesus Christ as personal Savior and Lord.
- Cell groups for Bible study and nurture of new believers for spiritual growth and maturity in the Faith, to become responsible Christians in their family, community and country.

Ministy Goal: By 2020 Uganda Grace Gospel Church of Christ Things to Come Mission should have 20 churches in 20 places and towns in Uganda. The ministry started with our registration, Sept. 10, 2004. October 24th we started Bible studies and tract distribution. Then we shifted to Uganda and established a temporary structure for worship which became a permanent building at Kirombe, Luzira Church. In 2006 we acquired land at Muyenga, Kyetyeba and built a stronger foundation for future use as worship center and Bible school as seen in the picture. We wanted to use this building for training people who are interested in ministry of reaching the lost for Christ and to become faithful servants of His for future generations.
